Volunteer Role Description

Fundraiser

Purpose of Role

To take part in fundraising activities which raise money for the Friends of York Hospitals.

Main Tasks

- Helping with a variety of fundraising initiatives, including stalls, benefit concerts and collections.
- Greeting members of the public in a friendly and approachable manner.
- Answering members of the publics' queries about FOYH, using publicity material provided.
- Counting cash accurately and looking after it securely.
- Attending relevant mentoring and training sessions when requested.
- Other duties as required, by agreement between the volunteer and FOYH personnel.

Skills and Personal Qualities Required

The role would suit someone who...

- Feels comfortable about meeting a succession of new people.
- Is sensitive about the context within which hospital related fundraising operates - ie a brash and brassy approach may not always be appropriate.
- Is reliable and willing to keep in contact.
- Is numerate.
- Is conscientious, especially regarding the security of the funds raised.
- Is interested in generating ideas for new fundraising events and initiatives for FOYH.

Availability Required

Volunteers are required on an as and when basis. They are asked to help for not usually more than 2 hours at any given fundraising event or stall.

Location

York Hospital and at local community events.

NB Fundraising Volunteers do not undertake activities at York Hospital anywhere but the public areas, ie Main Reception and Main Corridor.
